Download Library eBooks to a Kindle



You will need a valid library card, personal computer with Internet access, and Amazon.com account.

1. Start at your personal computer.

- Set up an Amazon account at *amazon.com*
- Go to *www.ocln.org*
- Click *Download ebooks & Audio* in the left sidebar.
- *Login* above the left sidebar and enter your library card barcode.

2. Next

- Click the *Kindle Link* in the left sidebar.
- Search the list of Kindle books.
- Click the Kindle selection to add the title to your *eBookBag*.
- Click *Proceed to Checkout*.
- Click *Confirm Checkout*.
- Click *Get for Kindle*.

3. Page opens to Amazon.com

- On *Get Your Public Library Loan Page*, click *Get Library Book*.
- Complete Amazon account form and click *Sign in Using Our Secure Server*.
- Choose *Deliver to Kindle OR Computer*.
If you choose *Deliver to Kindle*, you must have access to a wireless network.

- Click *Continue*.
- Popup *Available for Download* appears.
- Click *Actions*
- Click *Download* and Save on Desktop

4. Attach Kindle to computer with USB

- Open file on Kindle, drag book into documents folder on your Kindle

NOTE: Action button allows you to return book early.
